 Quarterly Mini-Grant Program for Teachers

This grant program is to enhance the visual, literary, and performing arts experiences of all Walton County school-age children K-12 in public, private 501C(3) schools, and home school groups through funding for special enhancement activities established by a teacher. Each awarded mini-grant will be up to \$350 and awarded to the teacher quarterly by the CAA Selection Committee.

Write a brief description of the activity proposed, the grade level or age group your project will target, and a list of the Florida Sunshine Standards the lesson will cover. Explain your vision about this specific program. What are your goals? Can you share these requested items with other teachers?

Provide a budget, time line, and, if possible, a picture with an explanation of the items to be purchased. Include the name(s) of the vendors.

You will be required to submit an evaluation documenting the success of your program within 30 days after completion of your project. What documentation will you be providing (i.e.: written report, video, photos, and/or recordings)? CAA Treasurer will make payment of awarded mini-grant upon receipt of CAA Selection Committee approval. You will not be eligible to receive another CAA grant until we receive the proper follow-up documentation.
