ANNUAL COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- Application must be completed in full and received by published deadline.
- Applicant must be a resident of Walton County at the time of application.
- Applicant must have declared or intend to declare a major in the arts.
- Awards will not exceed \$2,000 per year per applicant.
- Funds will be distributed directly to the award winner's college or university.
- Applicants may apply once per calendar year even if an award has been received previously.

APPLICATION MATERIALS

Your application should reflect your artistic personality and must include the following information:

- 1. Cover letter that includes reasons why you should be awarded a scholarship
- 2. List of accomplishments in your art discipline(s) and/or your portfolio
- 3. Most recent high school or college transcript
- 4. Support letter(s) from at least two references, one of whom is instructor in arts discipline
- 5. Any other materials that will support your application
